Yearbook

Fundraisers

The World's Finest Chocolate kickoff is on April 17. Students will attend a fun 20 minute assembly in the cafeteria regarding this, and boxes of chocolate will be given to students whose parents have sent in the signed letter, which will be sent home soon. There are 60 chocolate bars in each box and they sell for \$1 each. This is a very big fundraiser for us, a big contributor to the PTA and what goes back to the school.

Sweet Frog Spirit Night is on Thursday, April 27.

On the morning of Saturday, May 6, the Savers Fun Drive will be collecting donations (clothing, home decor, small appliances, smaller toys – must fit in a box – exact details will be shared as the date approaches). Savers will pay the PTA for our donations (based on weight). Monica will put together a tax donation receipt for those who request it. Cathy will put together a Sign-Up Genius for those who can help transport the donations that afternoon (we will need trucks).

Cathy is also placing a box in the school to collect sneakers (any conditions, all sizes, but only sneakers) for Got Sneakers. We receive a small amount of money (\$2-\$7) for each pair donated. This fundraiser will run year-round, so donate whenever you can!

We sold 70+ tickets for HersheyPark, netting almost \$150. Thank you to all who purchased!

Cathy and others are working on providing some fun snacks for that day too.

5th Grade Farewell and Field Trip

Important Dates/Events

Third quarter report card distribution for grades 1-5 was Wednesday, April 12. Parents have to log into Focus to view their child's report card. Teachers should have sent home information about how to do this. If they like, parents can request a hard-copy from their child's teacher.

Testing

MCAP scores from last year coming home soon. You will receive them if your child was in 3rd or 4th grade last year.

The MCAP testing window opens on April 17. Teachers will be working with their students that week to get them familiar with the platform and testing expectations.

MCAP testing at Fullerton starts on April 24. There will be three solid weeks of testing, although each child will not test each day. Grades 3-5 will complete the Math and ELA MCAP. Testing is in the morning, so the time of students' specials may change to account for this. If you have a child of testing age, please avoid morning appointments during these weeks.

MAP testing for K-2 starts on May 8.

All testing will be finished by May 26 (including make-ups).

Other

A parent asked about whether the PTA would offer college scholarships to former students. This has not been done in the recent past but was done at one point. In the past, we would have \$500-\$1000 to give to students, who would apply by writing an essay response to a question. This will be added to the agenda to discuss at our next meeting.
