- 2. Treasurer's Report
 - a. July & August starting budget: \$14,099.99
 - b. July & August expenses: \$1,431.66 (insurance, teacher allotments, PreK & K playdate, teacher breakfast)
 - c. July & August income: + \$698.24 (memberships, Kona fundraiser, GotSneaker fundraiser, Scentsy fundraiser)
 - d. July & August ending budget: \$13,366.42
 - e. Our 2023-24 budget will be confirmed at our next meeting.
- 3. Fundraising Report
 - a. Spirit Nights:
 - i. **Tuesday, September 19 at Chick-Fil-A in Perry Hall** Flyers will come home next week but you can just mention that you are from Fullerton.
 - ii. Wednesday, October 4 at Chipotle in White Marsh Flyers will be sent home that week and will include a code for online ordering; you can also buy in person and just mention Fullerton.
 - b. Penny Wars Send in your loose change to help your child's house win the penny war. Pennies and dollars add points for your child's house. Nickels, dimes, and quarters subtract points, so kids can "sabotage" another house. Collection buckets for each house are in the main lobby at Fullerton.

- e. Safety is a top priority for the teachers and administrators at Fullerton. Ms. Salkowski entrusts her staff to make a decision and err on the side of caution, if something seems unsafe.



- f. In the event of an incident at the school, the immediate focus is on securing the safety of the children and teachers, as well as communicating/coordinating with the police and then BCPS. If it's a major event, then communication will come directly from BCPS. If it's not a major event, then Ms. Salkowski will send out communications, but it may not be immediate.
