Yearbook

Fifth Grade

Upcoming Dates

School dismisses 3 hours early on Monday and Tuesday.

Brittany Jeffries proposed adding a new position to the PTA Board: a School Spirit Coordinator. Her proposal was seconded and then approved via voting.

Britni Hazel was nominated for the new position of School Spirit Coordinator. She accepted the nomination. It was voted on and she was approved.

Notes for Next Year

Please note that there is a two-year limit on each Board position. So if you are interested in serving on the Board in the future, please keep that in mind.

There is an outdated binder in the PTA closet explaining the role of each PTA position, as well as a list of previously held events. The binder includes expectations and explanations, dates and proposals, contacts, etc. However, it needs to be updated.

We also need to review and update our by-laws and submit them to the Maryland PTA.

Someone in the meeting proposed that we adopt an online payment option to make things easier. The great news is that we started this in the spring. We now use Cheddar Up to process payments for things.

Another person proposed that we adopt an online and/or anonymous voting system for next year.
