PTA helps support the cost of field trips, as the cost of the trips plus the transportation costs keep going up, and not all families can afford to pay the fees. Today, every single kindergartner was able to attend "The Cat in the Hat" field trip, and the PTA made that possible.

MISA (Maryland Integrated Science Assessment), which students take in 5th grade and 8th grade, is this week and next week. It is a very short window, so good attendance is super important!

Third, fourth, and fifth grade students have been completing the BCPS Stakeholder Survey in their classes this week. It is very short this year: it only takes about five

Ms. Wall (our school nurse) also pulls from these items when students need them. Every student who donated had their name put into a random name generator, and 10 students were selected to receive a prize.

Will there be a first grade field trip? The field trip that first graders used to go on is no longer an option, so the first grade teachers are working to find an alternative.

How is it determined who goes on field trips? Ms. Salkowski shared that she likes to see every student have an opportunity to go on a field trip each year. The details for each field trip are determined by the teachers of that grade level. There are a number of factors that must be considered: admission costs at the location, time and distance, cost/availability of transportation, how it connects to the curriculum, and safety.
